Yn 2010/20101 roedd 49 o ddisgyblion â datganiadau arnynt neu GYMEE, a nifer o ddisgyblion eraill a glustnodwyd fel rhai oedd ag angen cynhaliath. Tynnir disgyblion â datganiad allan o wersi pynciau craidd fel eu bod yn cael eu dysgu mewn grwpiau bach neu'n unigol. Rhoddir cefnogaeth hefyd mewn rhai gwersi yn y brif ffrwd. Rhoddir cymorth penodol mewn llythrennedd a rhifedd i nifer o ddisgyblion eraill mewn sesiynau byrion ar ddechrau'r dydd a sesiynau dysgu grwpiau bach. Mae cysylltiad agos rhwng yr Adran Anghenion Addysg Arbennig ac adrannau eraill, yn ogystal â chysylltiadau ag asiantau allanol e.e., Seicolegydd Addysgol sy'n ymweld â'r ysgol yn rheolaidd. Mae aelod o'r Llywodraethwyr, Mr. E. Davies, hefyd yn cysylltu â'r Adran.

Y llynedd dynodwyd swm o £762,676 ar gyfer gwaith addysg arbennig, ac fe'i defnyddiwyd ar gyfer staffio, offer TGCH, adnoddau a chyrsgiau.

Ar wahân i'r Pennaeth Adran, un athrawes gynnal rhan amser, un CALU, 9 NNEB a 18 gofalwraig yn gweithio yn yr ysgol.

Yn ychwanegol at waith arferol yr adran, mae'r Uned Sgiliau Bwywyd sydd yn darparu ar gyfer y disgyblion hynny sydd ddim yn medru ymdopi gydag addysg y brif ffrwd. Under his guidance and influence the DT department became known throughout Wales for its high standards. Mr Jones was recognized as an excellent teacher when he was awarded the DT Teacher of the Year in 2002. In addition Mrs Hilary Lewis left us after a period of 10 years as head of the Physics department. Mrs Lewis is an energetic and committed teacher who was respected by all. Her contribution to school life was immense. We wish them both the best of luck in their retirement.
3. This year again, the Governors have overseen the appraisal process for teaching staff at the school as well as evaluating standards by means of departmental reviews. This system has worked smoothly to all appearances.

The Governors were also pleased with the work of the school in mentoring student teachers and the induction of new teachers.

## CURRICULUM

The Governors are more than satisfied that the school provides a broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum. Matters concerning the curriculum were overseen by means of special meetings convened for that purpose. In addition to this, the Governors continued to receive termly reports from individual departments and Heads of School, This year the Governing body received reports and had discussions on primary secondary developments in English and science.

Details of the curriculum, as agreed by the Governors, are available from the school. Also, information is provided at appropriate stages during the school career of each pupil e.g:

The Chairperson would like to draw attention to the following:-

- \* That the school conforms to the statutory requirement of teaching courses at level 2 (GCSE) and at level 3 (A level)
- \* That we are cooperating with numerous partners in order to offer a wide and balanced curriculum and that the arrangements so far are working well.
- \* The arrangements for the Performance Management Cycle that includes departmental reviews and teaching staff appraisal.
- \* The further increase in school provision to support core/key skills and study skills for every age group by means of:-
  - holding a number of after school Study Clubs
  - continuing with the GCSE Revision Clubs partnership
  - the sharing of good practice amongst the staff
  - offering further support to help with Literacy and Numeracy
  - the implementation of strategies to help dyslexic children
  - the targeting of groups of pupils to improve their chances of gaining the key grades of C/A/A\*
  - the holding of lunch time clubs in numerous subjects
  - the implementation of assessment for learning strategies to support pupils with their work
  -
- \* Ensuring that there is a wide choice of subjects for post 16 pupils and to ensure progression from of Yr.12 into Yr.13. in order to conform with the Education Measure.
- \* The school is pleased to acknowledge all the extra curricular activities that have taken place during the year. Every Department has participated in some sort of extra curricular activity. This substantially enriches the education and experiences of our pupils. The success of Pupils in the Urdd National Eisteddfod in Swansea and the national Eisteddfod in Wrexham was greeted with much enthusiasm.
- \* A large number of pupils performed in various County and three County Orchestras and Choirs
- \* Many pupils gained success in the UK Maths Challenge competition.

- \* Year 12 DT pupils participated in the Engineering Education Scheme Wales competition again this year and were praised for their efforts. Rhys Davies won second prize in the WJEC Innovations Awards for work produced for the GCSE examinations .
- \* Travel and Tourism pupils arranged a trip to London.
- \* Pupils in the Art Department gained valuable experiences when they visited galleries in London and Paris.
- \* High points for many pupils were the skiing trip, the visit to Sweden, the expedition to Kenya and the visit to the WW1 battlefields of Ypres and the Somme, Many thanks to the members of staff that arranged these events and to the community for their support.
- \* Members of Yr 12 and 13 History classes visited the Houses of Parliament and House of Lords where they participated in a debate on passing new laws. They also followed in the steps of “Jack the Ripper” and spent time in the Victoria and Albert museum
- \* Mrs Lena Daniel organised a number of workshops with the “Crucial Team” for Year 7 who looked at Health and Safety issues. Trefnodd Mrs Lena Daniel nifer o weithgareddau gan y “criw Craff” oedd yn trafod diogelwch gyda disgyblion BI 7.
- \* The Eco – committee gained a Bronze award in the Eco Schools award

- Kyle Ward won a gold medal with the Dyfed relay team in the Welsh Athletics championship and a gold medal for West Wales in the inter regional championships. in the 100m Welsh Championships in Brecon
- Numerous pupils were chosen to represent Ceredigion/Dyfed in a variety of sports.

## EXTRA NEEDS

Special Educational Needs in the school are underscored by a School Policy and we can report that the work of the Department has been highly praised by the LEA pastoral advisors. In 2010-2011 there were 49 statemented or GYMEE pupils, and a number of other pupils who had been earmarked as needing various levels of support. Statemented pupils are withdrawn from core subject classes so that they can be taught in small groups or individually. Support is also provided in some mainstream lessons. A number of pupils are specifically given help in literacy and numeracy for short early-morning sessions as well as in small group teching sessions. There is a close liaison between the Special Needs Department and other Departments, as well as links with outside agencies e.g., Educational Psychologist, who visit the school regularly. A member of the Governing Body, Mr. E. Davies, also liaises with the Department.

Last year £762,676 was allocated for Special Needs requirements, and the money was used for staffing, ICT equipment, resources and courses.

Apart from the Head of Department, one part time support teacher, 1 HLTA, 9 NNEB's and 18 care assistants working at the school.

In addition to the usual work of the Department, the Basic Skills Unit cater for children who are unable to cope in the mainstream. The Unit prepares a vast range of needs and each pupil follow alternative curriculum. The Unit works side by side with another unit within the Department namely Ganolfan y Bont which caters for children with profound needs. Ganolfan y Bont consists of one teacher, 7 NNEB's and 4 support staff

English as an Additional language – one teacher and 1 PSW (funded through the County MELA project). Support is given in small EAL groups or through support in mainstream classes.

## SITE AND BUILDINGS

Matters concerning Site and Buildings were overseen by means of special meetings convened for that purpose.

The Governors would like to draw attention to the following developments which have taken place this year:-

- The refurbishment of the heating system in Ganolfan y Bont
- Improvements to the staff car park
- The opening of the astro turf playing field
- Rooms in both the Gym and the Canteen were painted
- Replacement of pipework in the Science corridors
- Minor improvements to classrooms and storerooms
- Minor repair and maintenance work, internally and externally.
- Refurbishing the Art Block
- Updating the school's IT system
- providing new equipment for the Engineering course
- Refurbishing three portacabins

The Governors have also supported priorities for the present year, which include:-

- Cooperating with the LEA to ensure further improvements to the Playing fields
- Plan for the future development of the school as part of the 3-19 programme
- Improvements to teaching rooms
- Painting a number of teaching rooms and storerooms.
- Minor repair and maintenance work, internally and externally
- The provision of new chairs for the Hall.

The Governors see the need for the Authority to provide:-

- a new and additional permanent block to house the Music, Drama and Humanities' department.
- providing space for the Integrated Family centre
- improvement to various parts of the old school building
- remove all the temporary buildings from the school site

It is the Governors' custom to visit various areas of the school regularly. In spite of the high standard of maintenance, the fabric of the school building requires constant care.

There was a great deal of satisfaction once again with the effective working of the School Lettings Policy and the constant and substantial use made of the facilities by the community.

The Governors wish to record their thanks to Mr. E. Thomas, site manager, for his hard work in maintaining the external appearance of the school grounds and to Mr G. Jones and his cleaning staff for the upkeep of the interior of the school buildings.

## LINKS WITH THE COMMUNITY

The Governors were pleased with the continuation - and development - of close and substantial links between the school and the community.

The school newsletter, "Y Bont", continues to appear every half-term, and is a direct link between school and parents and the wider community. There are frequent and detailed reports regarding school events and successes in the local papers and in "Clonc". Much information now appears on the revamped school web site.

Apart from this, there were many other examples of strong links with the community:-

- i. Developing our support for the Meals on Wheels provision.
- ii. Raising substantial sums of money for good causes of all kinds – Children in Need, Christian Aid, UNICEF, Operation Christmas Child, S4C Appeal, Comic Relief, Cancer Research, Tŷ Hafan, Cystic Fibrosis, Breast Cancer Wales, Habitat for Humanity, Race for Life, Dash, Teenage Cancer Trust and the Marie Curie Appeal, Dolen Cymru Lesotho, Bobath Children's Therapy Centre. The school also sponsors a young child in India.
- iii. Various links with primary schools and the Universities of Trinity and St. David's at Lampeter (– especially the Year 12/13 Curriculum Enrichment Programme) and Aberystwyth
- iv. Education/Industry links, including Work Experience and "Paving the Way" (when local business people are invited to school and pupils are sent out to visit businesses).
- v. Obtaining sponsorship from local people for all kinds of different activities.
- vi. Co-operating with the Police and other agencies on a pastoral programme.
- vii. Establishing a RAG forum in the school
- viii. Links with various organisations and bodies, including visits of an educational and social purpose e.g., West Wales Nature Trusts, Universities of Trinity and St. David's at Lampeter and Aberystwyth British Legion, churches and chapels.
- ix. Organisation of concerts, Prize Evening, contributing to radio and television programmes etc.
- x. Inviting parents and friends to join in certain school activities, mostly through the PTA which holds educational events as well as raising money. Parents are invited to events such as the school Eisteddfod and Sports.
- xi. Inviting individuals and groups to address educate and train pupils.
- xii. Taking part in competitions and, by doing so successfully, bringing recognition to the community as well as the school e.g.

The Governors appreciated the close and dynamic links between the school and community in all their various aspects.

## EXAMINATIONS

The results of the 2011 external examinations are appended. The Governors wish to congratulate pupils and staff on their success, and would emphasise that they are proud of the general standing of the school.

At A/GNVQ level the school had outstanding results once again. 80% of the grades were A – C grades, and the percentage of A-E grades was 99.3%

At GCSE the number who obtained 5 C grades or above was 75%, and 94.8% of Yr. 11 pupils succeeded in gaining at least 5 A-G grades or higher.
